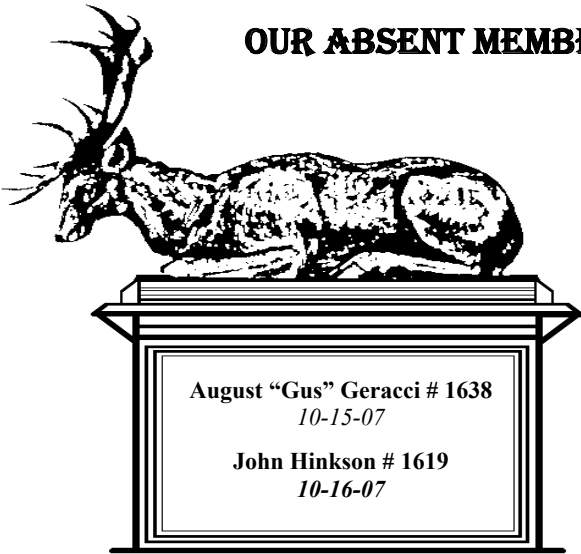
Secretary's Message
