L.O.E. President's Message

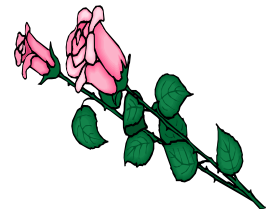
Dear Members;
