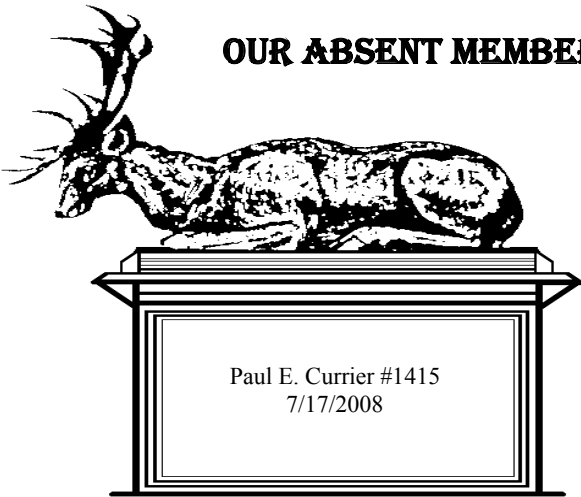


Secretary's Message

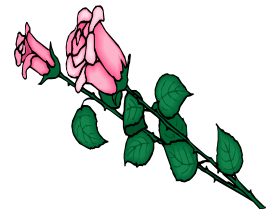
L.O.E. President's Message
